Terms and Conditions

Price:

The retreat cost includes accommodations (except option D below), all meals, and the retreat fee.

25% Deposit is due now. The remaining balance is due September 1, 2024

Prices below include all meals and lodging (no lodging for Option D) starting with dinner on Monday and ending with breakfast on Saturday. Vegan/vegetarian/gluten-free meals are available at an additional price of \$70 (14 meals).

Cancellation/Refund Policy:

There will be a 10% fee for cancellations and refunds. No refunds will be made after October 15, 2024.

About the Accommodations:

The Marianist Retreat and Conference Center served as a monastery for 65 years. That said, the accommodations are what you would expect at a monastery. There are no televisions or refrigerators in the rooms. Daily maid service is not available. The Center uses a specific set of check-out procedures which can be found on the wall of each room. Failure to follow these procedures will result in a \$50 fee.

Each guest will be provided with a room key (one key per room). A \$25 fee will be collected for each lost room key.

Each room has:

- A private bath with a stand-up shower and support bars at the toilet. (Use of the shower requires transferring from the wheelchair to a bath stool if needed – available on request.)
- A window to the outside.
- A fan with speed control.
- An extra blanket.

Participants are not permitted to bring in electrical appliances such as microwaves, crock pots, refrigerators, etc.

The Center reserves the right to enter rooms for repair, inspection, or emergency as needed by maintenance staff, fire, or police departments.

Meals are included in every option.

- Special meal requests, i.e., Vegan/Vegetarian/Gluten-Free are available at an additional cost of \$5 per meal (\$70 for 14 meals). If you wish to order these types of meals, you will have an opportunity to complete a special meal form to be provided at a later date.
- The meal schedule is as follows:
 - Breakfast – 8:00 a.m.
 - Lunch – 12:00 p.m.
 - Dinner – 5:00 p.m.
- All food, dishes, and utensils provided by the Center must remain in the dining room.
- Please note: You may bring your own snacks/beverages, however, they may not be kept in conference rooms or sleeping rooms. Refrigerated items can be stored in the guest refrigerator located in the lower lobby. Non-perishable snacks and beverages can be stored at the tables provided in the main and lower lobbies. A microwave is available there. Cups with lids must be used in the conference room and sleeping rooms. No drinks are allowed in the chapel.

Travel:

By air, please plan to arrive at the St. Louis, MO Lambert International Airport (STL) on Monday, November 18, 2024. You may check in to the Marianist Center after 12:00 noon. Please plan to depart on Saturday, November 23, 2024. Check-out time is no later than 10:00 a.m.

Although there are numerous options for the 30-mile transport from the airport to the Marianist Center and back, STL Shuttle Service will be providing van shuttles throughout the day. (Monday, 11/18/24 and Saturday, 11/23/24.) Reservation and payment information can be arranged through www.stlshuttleservice.com or by calling 314-450-6453.

By car: The Marianist Retreat and Conference Center is located at 4000 Highway 109, Eureka, MO 63025. We recommend you use Google Maps to determine your best route.

Candles/Incense:

Candles and incense must be in fireproof or glass containers and have a fireproof or glass dish underneath them. All candles should be extinguished before leaving a room. If candle wax is spilled, a \$100 cleaning fee per area will be charged. Due to insurance demands, no hand-held, flame-lit candles are allowed.

WiFi and Cell Phone Use:

Please plan to silence your cell phone during the sessions. To honor the privacy of all participants, the use of cell phones to record videos is prohibited. Still photos are allowed with each subject's permission. Wi-Fi is available throughout the facility.

Substance Use:

The Marianist Retreat and Conference Center is a smoke-free building. The use of tobacco, e-cigarettes, vape pens, cartridges containing liquid nicotine, or other synthetic products is prohibited inside the building. Designated smoking areas are located on the front and back patios. Please use the cigarette receptacles.

The use of cannabis and illegal drugs is strictly prohibited anywhere on the premises.

Firearms:

Possession or use of firearms, weapons, ammunition, fireworks, explosives, and highly flammable materials is prohibited anywhere on the premises.

Use of areas:

Groups may not use marking tape on the floors.

The movement of furniture described below is prohibited.

- Couch
- Ave Maria coffee table
- Pink chairs
- Gliders
- Chapel Altar

Removal of statues, wall hangings, artwork, or signs from the Center's walls is not allowed. This includes all general-use areas, hallways, and sleeping rooms.

Lost items:

Take Me to Truth will create a "lost and found" box in the main conference room.

The Center is not responsible for items left on the premises. It may discard any items not claimed within 30 days after completion of the retreat.
